# Fr. Terry Keehan

Fr. Kurt Boras, my classmate, will move into our Rectory over the next month. Kurt has recently been named one of the Vicars for Priests for the Archdiocese of Chicago by Cardinal Cupich, a ministry that supports all of our priests in a variety of our needs. This ministry will be his primary focus but he will live here at Holy Family. As a resident priest his involvement with us will be limited, but nevertheless I know that you will get to know and appreciate his many talents. Our staff has been very supportive as they have gotten to know Kurt initially and affirm that he will add a lot to our community. Please give Fr. Kurt a warm Holy Family welcome. His own words of introduction follow:

## Greetings, peace and blessings of health to you, the good people of Holy Family Parish.



I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself to you. My name is Kurt D. Boras. I was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Chicago in 1986 by Joseph Cardinal Bernardin.

Fr. Terry, your pastor, and I are classmates (but please don't hold that against me...only kidding, Terry)! Actually, I respect Fr. Terry, his pastoral style, his leadership, and his spirit of hospitality very much. That is why I called up my classmate and asked if I could come pray, live and serve with him and your very gifted pastoral staff at Holy Family while serving as one of the Vicars for Priests for the Archdiocese full time. To serve in being the "Pastor to the Pastors" as Cardinal Cupich said in his appointment letter to me, I still wanted to be around REAL PEOPLE, dedicated to their faith and committed to walking with the Lord. But in my "heart of hearts" I have always considered myself first and foremost, a PARISH PRIEST. Before receiving my new assignment as Vicar I served 10 years as the pastor of St. Patrick Parish in Lemont, a far southwestern suburb, amongst the awesome people of faith there. I miss them a lot already, but I do know, and the good people of St. Patrick confirmed it in so many loving ways, that the Lord was calling me to serve in this new capacity for the Archdiocese.

I come among you as a Southsider, born and raised in the Midway Airport area. However, I am a very passionate Chicago Cubs fan. You might see this "blurt out of me" from time to time. I see my journey here on earth as a "lifelong learner." I am curious about many areas of study. I hold graduate degrees in theology, clinical counseling, and spiritual direction. I am finishing my Doctorate in Psychology (Psy.D.) by looking at the works of Viktor Frankl and how they relate to the spiritual journey. I hold certificates in addiction and grief counseling. In my free time, I like to be with family and good friends. I love all sports, but am partial to baseball since I was able to play it on the semi-professional level into my mid-twenties.

I am humbled to be the first cousin of Gary Fencik, the captain and hard hitting safety of the Super Bowl winning 1985 Chicago Bears. (I know you will immediately make the connection once you meet me because the resemblance is so uncanny.) We grew up together and I am simply delighted in all of the accomplishments that he has achieved. Besides the Super Bowl win, Gary graduated from Yale University, received his MBA from Northwestern Kellogg School of Business, and is a highly respected and successful businessman for Adams Street Partners. He has always been supportive of me and my vocation and generous with his time when I have asked him for a favor or two in making public appearances. I am trying to let him enjoy his retirement these days, but like a BIG BROTHER I know he is always there for me.

That is a little bit about me and what makes me "tick!" I so look forward to "meeting you" in whatever way that is possible in these days of pandemic and "hearing your stories." ## Faith Parents consider the following

### **Like all learning, religious education requires consistency.**

If you skip this year, your child/teen will, not only lose out on this year's religious education, but incur learning losses from previous years.

### **Advantages of Digital Learning**

- **E-Learning is a safer option** at this time.
- **E-Learning provides families with the most flexibility.**
- **E-learning is often more efficient.**
- **E-learning offers us the possibility of personalizing faith formation**, by catering to individual needs. It allows learners to choose their learning path and navigate at their own pace.
- **E-learning leads to better retention.** Modern learners prefer bite-sized, interactive content. E-learning tools enable us to make content interactive.
- **E-learning allows us to engage** our children, teens and parents in new ways.

## Questions Parents are asking about Faith Classes

**Will the FTF schedule remain the same?** We are staying quite close to our normal schedule (September-April). The digital learning lessons will be designed to go for 45 minutes rather than our regular 90-minute lessons.

**Are you expecting parents to teach their own children if we opt for at home digital learning?** **NO!** The teaching part of the lesson will be presented via pre-recorded short videos. If Teen Faith families choose the weekly Zoom classes, Catechists and peer ministers provide the instruction.

Each lesson will include a range of engaging ways for children, teens and parents to choose from in exploring and sharing their faith with one another. For families with younger children, each e-learning lesson is designed to meet the needs of all grade levels, as opposed to separate lessons for each child. Families can do the e-lessons when it is most convenient for their schedule.

**Is digital religious education effective?** We believe, of course, in-person classes are more beneficial over all. However, at this time it is simply not safe to do so. We also recognize there are advantages digital learning provides (see sidebar)

**How will children/teens/families receive their materials?** Lesson plans will be posted on the Parish website, along with Flipgrid or Google Classroom links. Families will select a date and time via Sign-Up Genius at the beginning of September to pick-up the other materials they will need to complete the lessons.

**Will Tuition Remain the Same?** This year we will only use the participating parishioner rate. The Home Faith Tuition scale will follow the same schedule. The 2020-21 tuition schedule is available on the registration link –

Salaries and benefits account for 70% of our annual budget. At the end of June, we cut one full-time position from FTF. Further staff cuts would result in cutting services. We will still need to purchase books and supplies, and this year we will have to pay subscriptions for some e-learning platforms and digital learning tools as well. Some of the learning aids we use in the various classrooms from year to year will now have to be purchased, so each family has access to them.

*The Job Support Group was the first established ministry at Holy Family. They have had a very busy year, especially when COVID-19 hit and people began to lose their jobs. We thank the leadership team for their continued guidance and support of the unemployed and underemployed. A summary of the past fiscal year gives a glimpse into their work.*

### Job Support Group 2019-2020 Annual Report

It was a year of extremes for this ministry. We had one of the best economies in many years in July 2019 with unemployment hitting a record low of 3.5% in December 2019. The next month we were hit with the COVID 19 Pandemic and unemployment went straight up to a modern day record of 14.70% in April 2020. We had to move our weekly meetings at the church to an online platform (Zoom) and we continue to meet this way with a very robust attendance. We began the year with 18) 24/7 advisors and finished with the same number. We also moved our weekly registration to an online electric reporting system (Eventbrite) in January so that we will have better and more accurate reporting. We also built a new website for our job seekers. Last, we added a new program for job seekers by adding workshops for the unemployed in Resume writing, LinkedIn prep and interview skills to a name a few. This was in conjunction with the new Barrington Career Center but our workshops are offered for no charge to our ministry.

Annual Numbers with previous year number in parenthesis:

- Meetings 52 (52)
- Attendance - Job seekers 1,256 (789) - 24/7 advisors 535 (518)
- First time attendees 172 (112) - dramatic increase from March through June.
- Job Landings 63 (64) -This number is always underreported because many people do not officially report as having landed.
- Advisor Volunteer Hours - 1,605 (1,295) - This is a conservative number as many advisor's do weekly meetings and one-on-one sessions with individual job seekers. This goes unreported.
- Workshops - New in March 2020 - we had 15 workshops (4 on campus and 11 via Zoom) with 36 individual's attending 78 sessions.
